

Pool Rules

General Rules:

- 1. All children under 8 years of age must be supervised by a person 14 years of age or older. Supervising person must supervise the child at all times, in and around the swimming pool.
- 2. No person shall be under the influence of drugs or alcohol while in the facility. Drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited.
- 3. Smoking or the use of smokeless tobacco, or vapes are not permitted inside the facility.
- 4. Glass containers are not permitted.
- 5. Animals of any kind are not permitted, except for working dogs which must be clearly marked with appropriate vest.
- 6. Abusive or inappropriate language will not be permitted at any time.
- 7. No running or rough play.
- 8. NO BBQ's
- 9. RLERPD is not responsible for personal property.
- 10. RLERPD reserves the right to limit admission due to safety considerations.
- 11. Admission to the pool may be refused to any person having a contagious, infectious, or communicable disease; including open cuts, sores, wounds, etc. These quests will not be allowed in the pool.
- 12. No skateboards, rollerblades, or bikes are allowed inside the pool facility.
- 13. Pool may close due to inclement weather.
- 14. Ice chests will be checked before entering the facility.
- 15. Conversations with lifeguard should be limited. Please direct any problems, concerns, or questions to the Pool Manager.
- 16. Twin Rivers students MUST show ID to enter the pool at no cost, if students don't have ID, they will have to pay the admission fee.
- 17. Guests must obey lifeguards and aquatic staff instructions at all times. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from the facility.



Pool Rules:

- 1. No one will enter the pool unless a qualified lifeguard is on duty.
- 2. Only proper swim attire will be permitted in the pool. No jean shorts, under garments, or cut-offs will be allowed. No shorts with metal snaps or zippers will be allowed. T-shirts must be tucked in or tied at the waste.
- 3. Toddlers not potty trained must wear swim diapers.
- 4. Showers are required before entering the pool.
- 5. No prolonged underwater swimming or breath holding.
- 6. Spitting or spouting of water in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- 7. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved personal safety flotation life vests are permitted in the pool. Life vests must fit properly and the non-swimmer must be within arms' reach of an adult at all times.
- 8. No Swimmies, Water Wings, Floaties, rafts, body boards, Frisbees, water guns, or inflatables are permitted in the pool.
- 9. No snorkeling or scuba equipment is allowed.
- 10. Flipping, throwing, sitting on the shoulders, piggyback rides, and other unsafe activities are not permitted.
- 11. Holding, standing, or hanging on the pool rope, lane lines, or ladders is prohibited.
- 12. Use only the designated pool entrance/exit.
- 13. No food, gum, or drinks are permitted inside the pool.
- 14. Lifeguards have the right to stop any play which they deem dangerous.
- 15. Guests must obey lifeguards and aquatic staff instructions at all times. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from the facility.



Slide Rules

- 1. The water slide is only open for use during designated times.
- 2. Patrons must take a swim test before riding the slide.
- 3. Masks, goggles, or glasses may not be worn while sliding.
- 4. Swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets, or metal are not permitted.
- 5. T-shirts must be tucked in or tied at the waste.
- 6. Pregnant women and persons with heart conditions or back trouble should not ride the slide.
- 7. Patrons must wait in line off of the platform until directed by a lifeguard.
- 8. Two patrons may go down the slides simultaneously (one rider per slide at a time). The slides may not be directly next to each other.
- 9. Patrons are not permitted to ride with children in their lap.
- 10. Patrons must wait for the lifeguard's start signal before going down.
- 11. Slides must be ridden feet first, lying on your back.
- 12. Once finished sliding, patrons must immediately swim to the ladder and exit the pool.
- 13. Diving into or out of, kneeling, changing positions, slowing down, stopping, forming chains, or sliding head first is prohibited.
- 14. Guests must obey lifeguards and aquatic staff instructions at all times. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from the facility.
